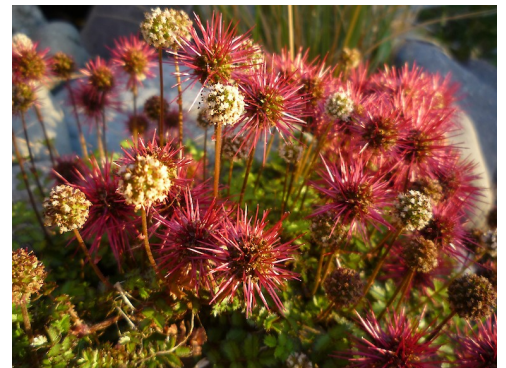
microphylla: Small leaf
