## LIFE CYCLE

Winged seeds are dispersed by water and possibly also wind and ballistic projection (Thorsen et al., 2009).

## ETYMOLOGY

**colobanthus**: Mutilated flower with no petals

**strictus**: From the Latin strictus 'upright, stiff'
