#### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION**

Characterised by the corticolous (occasionally saxicolous) habit; the paleyellow (in part) medulla; pustulate isidia which do not (or only sparingly) become sorediate; and gyrophoric acid in the medulla.

## **DISTRIBUTION**

**North Island**: Northland to Taranaki. **South Island**: Canterbury (Hanmer) to Otago (Dunedin). **Auckland Islands**.

Cosmopolitan. Common in the pantropics being known from East Africa, Zimbabwe, South Africa, Japan, Papua New Guinea, Australia and New Caledonia.

#### **HABITAT**

On both native and introduced trees and shrubs (especially on \*Acacia), and occasionally on rocks in grassland.

# **DETAILED DESCRIPTION**

**Chemistry**: Cortex K+ yellow; medulla K-, C+ rose, KC+ rose, Pd-; comtaining atranorin, chloroatranorin, gyrophoric acid (major), 5-O-methylhiascic acid (minor) and umbilicaric acid (minor) (Elix & Wardlaw 2000).

#### **SUBSTRATE**

Corticolous
