## **DETAILED DESCRIPTION**

**Roots** fibrous. **Stems** about 45–60 cm tall. **Leaf-sheaths** smooth, overlapping on one another. **Leaf blades** 3–6 mm wide, flat, slightly rough on upper surfaces. **Spikes** long and narrow with 2 rows of small flattened spikelets placed edgewise to the stem. **Outer glume** of spikelet as long as or longer than spikelet, sharply pointed. (Wax, Fawcett and Isely 1981)
