# **DETAILED DESCRIPTION**

Grass-like tufted plant, invariably stoloniferous. **Leaves** reddish green. **Flowering stems** (4–)15–35(–80) cm long. **Inflorescence** of several 3–25 flowered clusters, peduncles 1–6 cm. long; subtending bracts usually much less than inflorescence. **Tepals** ovate-lanceolate, acute, bright chestnut brown with broad, white, membranous margins. **Capsule** more or less equal to tepals, dark red-brown, often almost black towards the tip.

## **SIMILAR TAXA**

Luzula picta var. limosa differs from <u>Luzula picta var. picta</u> and <u>Luzula subclavata</u> by usually having acute tepals, and dark red-brown mature capsules which are more or less equal in length to tepals.
