#### **NOTES ON TAXONOMY**

As currently circumscribed <u>Muehlenbeckia complexa</u> and <u>M. australis</u> remain highly variable species within which there may be cause to recognise additional taxa. Some of these have names. <u>Muehlenbeckia complexa</u> var. <u>grandifolia</u> is one of these, being regarded, increasingly, by New Zealand botanists as worthy of reinstatement. At the very least it deserves critical study, along with the other variants within <u>M. complexa</u> s.l., which include a distinct, large, and glossy-leaved, northern offshore island race, which is linked to var. <u>grandifolia</u> by its uniformly hairy stems.
