#### **SIMILAR TAXA**

R. wichuraiana hybrid cv. 'Alberic Barbier' petals pale yellow in bud, cream or whitish at anthesis, 2-4.5 cm long; flowers double; leaflets of vegetative shoots usually 4-6 x 2-3 cm glossy deep green. R. wichuraiana hybrids 'Dorothy Perkins' group: petals white to crimson in bud, either whitish to crimson and 1-2 cm at anthesis, or rose or crimson and > 2 cm long; either flowers double and leaflets of vegetative shoots usually 1-3.5 x 1-2 cm or flowers single and leaflets of vegetative shoots usually > 3.5 x 2 cm; leaflets usually bright glossy green.
