## **BRIEF DESCRIPTION**

Rhizomatous perennial, stems straggling to ascending, branching at regular intervals ('zigzag'), hairy. Leaves hairy below, glabrous above, leaflets lacking the crescent markings typical of T. pratense; more narrow than in T. pratense. Flower heads stalked; calyx teeth unequal, linear.

#### **DISTRIBUTION**

'Waikato, Molesworth, Oamaru. Rare casual of waste places and cultivated land, formerly more widespread" (Webb et al. 1988). Bushy Park near Wanganui 2014.

# **HABITAT**

Old pasture, waste places, cultivated land.

# **SIMILAR TAXA**

Red clover, Trifolium pratense. Some differences noted in the description above.
