## Notes

### The following native species are notable occurrences:

*Carex spinirostris*: mostly in lowland forest, especially coastal forest, of northern half of North Island, uncommon further south; two records for Wanganui Conservancy (the other at Brunswick, Wanganui, on limestone in forest). Not recorded as present in North Taranaki ED by Bayfield et al. (1991)

*Carex* sp. [unnamed; cf *C. raoulii* and *C. testacea*]: not uncommon sedge of coastal scrub and forests, but seemingly rare in Wanganui Conservancy.

*Cyathea cunninghamii*: scattered but uncommon in Wanganui Conservancy.

*Hypolepis dicksonioides*: few locations in Wanganui Conservancy, mostly in disturbed sites (Rapanui, Oakura, Hawera) - the Paparoa site is the most natural site known here.

*Pteris saxatilis*: a fern of coastal forests, common only from Auckland northwards; Paparoa cliffs are the only recent record in Wanganui Conservancy, but recorded from Waipingau Stream/White Cliffs area by Druce and Ogle (1972).
