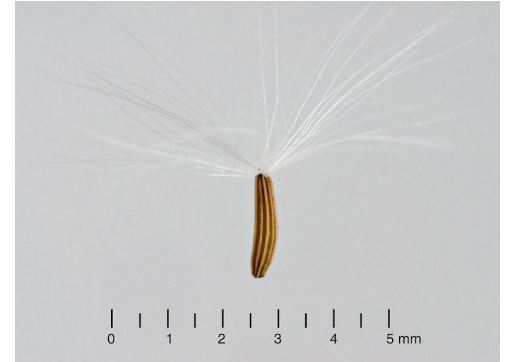
capillaris: From the Latin capillus 'hair' or 'thread', meaning hair-like or thread-like
