Almost always is a hydrophyte, rarely in uplands (non-wetlands).

Stigma deeply 4 lobed; Stems covered with long spreading hairs; leaves subsessile.

ETYMOLOGY

epilobium: From the Greek epi- 'upon' and lobos 'a pod', the flowers appearing to be growing on the seed pod.
