coarse club-rush

## HABITAT

Short-stature, open vegetation on wetland margins and dune hollows, or in dry sites such as coastal cliff-tops.

## DETAILED TAXONOMY

### FAMILY

Cyperaceae

### AUTHORITY

*Ficinia marginata* (Thunb.) A.Dietr.

### SYNONYMS

*Isolepis marginata* (Thunb.) A.Dietr.; *Scirpus marginatus* Thunb.; *Ficinia marginata* (Thunb.) Fourc.

### TAXONOMIC NOTES

To achieve monophyly of *Ficinia*, a subset of *Isolepis* species grouped from a nuclear phylogeny, including *I. marginata*, have been reclassified as *Ficinia*. These species were resolved outside the core *Isolepis*.

Although they lack a gynophore (a stalk or stipe raising the base of the ovary above the level of attachment of the perianth), a diagnostic for *Ficinia*, the authors (Muasya & Larridon 2021) felt it was better to place them in that genus.

## ETYMOLOGY

**ficinia**: Named after Heinrich David Auguste Ficus, 19th century German botanist

**marginata**: From the Latin marginatus 'edge, margin', where one colour is surrounded by a very narrow rim of another
